

**RELEASE**

I, the undersigned, hereby declare as follows:

That I have been informed it is the policy of the Westborough Water District not to turn on any water service unless the customer is present at the time said water is turned on.

That I am unable to be present when the water service is turned on and I desire that the Westborough Water District turn said water on without my presence at the premises.

I do hereby further absolve and agree to hold harmless the Westborough Water District for any and all liability that may occur due to the fact that damage occurred to my property in any manner or respect, whether property damage, bodily injury or any other type of damage, by reason of turning on the water by the Westborough Water District.

It is further understood and I do hereby waive the provisions of S1542 of the Civil Code, which reads as follows:

"A general release does not extend to claims which the creditor does not know or suspect to exist in his favor at the time of executing the release, which if known by him must have materially affected his settlement with the debtor."

That I have fully read the foregoing release and declaration and understand that by signing this declaration and release, I hereby absolve the Westborough Water District from any and all liability and any nature or extent whatsoever as a result of the Westborough Water District turning on the water without my personal presence on the premises.
